DIRECTOR'S REPORT

ELECTION PROGRAMMING: Staff continues to work on behind the scenes election preparation including candidate filing information, legal notices, mapping, monthly reports and removals. We have begun to receive inquiries for local offices that will appear on the ballot in 2020. Our staff is actively engaged in weekly trainings and informational webinars with the NCSBOE. As we approach filing for the municipal elections in July, we are seeing an upswing in voter registration. In addition, our office is receiving a lot of calls because of two groups that are sending out voter registration applications. Those groups are the Voter Participation Center and the Center for Voter Information. Many of the voters receiving the mailings are already registered and because the mailings appear to come from the local BOE, they are confused. We are also seeing registrations that are for deceased voters that have been removed from our database. The SBOE has provided the contact number for these groups to boards of election and asked that we refer citizens to them. The SBOE provided a spreadsheet to each county board and Warren had approximately 800 voters that received these mailings.

BUDGET: The Warren County Board of Commissioners recently passed the budget for the 2019-2020 year. All BOE request were funded as submitted with the voter equipment being removed. It is the understanding that if the SBOE is able to certify and the board approve purchase of new equipment the county commissioners will appropriate from fund balance to cover our request. We have been following developments at the SBOE and hope to see action taken in the near future.

CENSUS: Through the complete count committee, we have conducted on site job opportunities both at the Job Service office as well at the Warren County Armory. Turnout has been very low. These jobs offer above average wages for the area. We have conducted live radio interviews on WARR, but there are still job opportunities here in the county.
