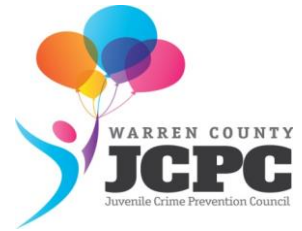


WARREN COUNTY

Meeting called to order by Vice-Chair.

Program Review

- **Youth Services Bureau Teen Court:** Debbie Scott presented documentation of report and YSB January monthly events calendar highlighting the upcoming events of the YSB program and Teen Court dates. Beginning count is 9 with no new admission and an ending count of 9 youth. Transporting youth for jury duty in Granville County. In December, YSB hosted its Annual Christmas Celebration at the Armory Civic Center with Teen Court and Afterschool program students and parents in attendance. Norlina Police Department attended event and spoke with the youth and families about what he does. Teen Court Summit will be in Concord, NC in April. SPEP information received.
- **YSB Community Service Restitution:** Debbie Scott presented documentation of report for December 2017 with a beginning count of 7 with 1 successful completion for an ending count of 6 youth; total served year to date is 14.
- **Boys & Girls Club/ Positive Action:** Floyd Johnson presented documentation of report for November 2017 with a beginning count of 15 with 3 new admissions for an ending count of 18 youth. For December 2017, beginning count of 18 with 2 new admissions referred by the school counselor for an ending count of 20 youth. Mr. Terrell Alston is no longer with the B&GC and

Mr. Floyd Johnson is overseeing the four sites in Warren County and working with DSS to continue referral process.
