Rural Operating Assistance Program (ROAP)**

This is to inform the public of the opportunity to attend a public hearing on the proposed Rural Operating Assistance Program (ROAP) application to be submitted to the NC Department of Transportation no later than December 1, 2009 by the County of Warren. The public hearing will be held on Monday, November 23, 2009 at 5:30 pm at the Warren County Memorial Library Community Meeting Room, 109 S. Front Street, Warrenton, NC. A special meeting to approve FY 2010 ROAP application will be held at 5:45 pm immediately after the public hearing. Warren County will provide auxiliary aids and services under the ADA for disabled persons who wish to participate in the hearing. Anyone requiring special services should contact Charles Walton in the Department of Social Services at (252-257-5024) as soon as possible so that arrangements can be made.

The programs included in the Rural Operating Assistance Program (ROAP) application are:

1. Elderly & Disabled Transportation Assistance (EDTAP) Program provides operating assistance for the transportation of elderly and disabled citizens. This transportation assistance allows for the individual to reside for longer periods in their homes, thereby enhancing their quality of life. For the purpose of EDTAP, an elderly person is defined as one who reaches the age of 60 or more years. A disabled person is defined as one who has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities, an individual who has a record of such impairment, or an individual who is regarded as having such impairment.
2. Employment transportation Assistance Program is intended to provide operating assistance for transitional Work First, Workforce Development Programs and general public employment transportation needs. These funds are used to support the employment transportation needs of individuals that are not eligible to receive benefits from the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program.
3. Rural General Public (RGP) Program funds are intended to provide transportation service to individuals who are not human service agency clients.

The period of performance for Rural Operating Assistance Program funds is July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. The FY 10 ROAP individual program totals are:

Se celebrará una reunión especial para aprobar el año 2010 ROAP aplicación a las 5: 45 horas inmediatamente después de la audiencia pública. Condado de Warren proporcionará ayudas auxiliares y servicios bajo la ADA para las personas con discapacidad que deseen participar en la audiencia. Los programas incluido en el rural operativo Assistance Program (ROAP) son de aplicación:

1. Ancianos y discapacitados Programa de asistencia (EDTAP) de transporte proporciona asistencia operativo para el transporte de los ciudadanos ancianos y discapacitados. Esto asistencia de transporte permite para que el individuo a residir durante más tiempo períodos en sus hogares, mejorando su calidad de vida. Para la propósito de EDTAP, una persona de edad avanzada se define como alguien que llega a la edad de 60 o más años. Una persona con discapacidad se define como alguien que tiene un deficiencia física o mental que limite sustancialmente una o más importantes las actividades de la vida, un individuo que tiene un registro de dicha deficiencia, o un persona que se considera que dicho deterioro.
2. Transporte de empleo Programa de asistencia está diseñado para proporcionar asistencia operativo para transitoria primera de trabajo, desarrollo de la fuerza laboral y público en general necesidades de transporte de empleo. Estos fondos se utilizan para apoyar la las necesidades de transporte de empleo de las personas que no son elegibles para recibir beneficios de la ayuda temporal para familias necesitadas (TANF) programa.
3. Público en general las zonas rurales (PSI) Fondos del programa están diseñados para ofrecer el servicio de transporte a personas que no sean clientes de la Agencia de servicios humanos.
