POSITION: Deputy Sheriff*

DUTIES: Performs a variety of law enforcement & protective service duties such as serving warrants & subpoenas, testifying in court, & making arrests; does related work as required.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, & ABILITIES: Must possess a working knowledge of law enforcement principles, practices, methods, & equipment.

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE: Graduation from high school; some law enforcement training or experience preferred.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must be at least 21 years of age & possess a valid NC driver's license; position requires certification as a law enforcement officer in accordance with the NC Criminal Justice Training & Standards Council. If not presently certified, applicant may gain probationary employment with one (1) opportunity to obtain certification.

*Minimum requirements for employment are established by the NC Sheriff's Education & Training Standards, as well as the Warren County Sheriff's Office & must be met in order to qualify for & retain employment. These requirements include, in part, that the applicant must: possess or immediately obtain BLET certification; be a U.S. citizen (or provide proof of naturalization); have no felony or serious misdemeanor charges/convictions; be of good moral character.
