If not presently certified, applicant may gain probationary employment with one (1) opportunity to obtain certification.

These requirements include, in part, that the applicant must: possess or immediately obtain BLET certification; be a U.S. citizen (or provide proof of naturalization); have no felony or serious misdemeanor charges/convictions; be of good moral character.
